

Knox Kids Camp 2018 TEAM MEMBER JOB DESCRIPTION

Position Summary

Knox Kids Camp offers weekly full day faith-based summer programs for children. Children are encouraged to develop skills and self-confidence and to learn how to live in Christian community with their peers. High school-aged Team Members are offered the chance to develop leadership skills such as teaching, drama, public speaking and program implementation as they care for the campers. They will grow and share their faith, uncover gifts and serve God within a Christian community. Team Members are hired by the Camp Director, Program Director and Knox Kids' Camp Design Team of Knox Presbyterian Church, Woodstock. They are supervised by the Camp Director and Program Director who are responsible for all aspects of the camp and the overall well-being of the Team.

Employment Period: July 9th to August 24th, 2018 (7 weeks Camp) (August 6th is a holiday) There will be an accumulation of up to one (1) week for training July 2nd-6th, and one Saturday following camp for clean up. *Time off must be approved at least 2 weeks in advance by the Camp Director.*

Duties and Responsibilities

- a) Participate in the Team Training period in July.
- b) Assist in pre-planning of activities based on weekly themes.
- c) Set up and prepare for daily activities and organize supplies and equipment.
- d) Follow provided curriculum to assist, co-lead or lead high quality, hands on activities.
- e) Provide supervision to children during Before and After Care, morning programs and afternoon all-camp activities on and off site.
- f) Take on a variety of leadership roles (i.e. group leader, workshop leader, support) and be flexible when changing tasks is necessary to provide support or coverage.
- g) Attend all scheduled activities of the Team including meetings and devotions.
- h) Work cooperatively with all Staff and Team Members to make the Camp run smoothly, creatively, and safely.
- i) Respect the authority of the Camp Director, Program Director, Design Team and Knox Staff.
- j) To bring their own lunch each day.

Qualifications

1. Minimum completion of grade 9 (At start date of camp).
2. Demonstrated ability to work and interact with children.
3. Proven ability to work with others and form a team.
4. Willingness to accept responsibility for self and others in their care.
5. Desire to grow and learn.
